

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-0816-001

A ORDINANCE OF THE PRAIRIE VIEW CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT CALLING FOR AN ELECTION REFERENDUM TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2021 TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT AND ITS ONE-FOURTH CENT (.002500%) SALES TAX FOR A PERIOD OF 5 YEARS.

WHEREAS, the current authorization for the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District, codified under Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code will expire on March 31, 2022 and

WHEREAS, Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code provides for a process by which the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District shall continue beyond its initial term, if an election is held and the majority of votes cast in said election are in favor of the continuation of the District; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 363 further provides that the Board of Directors of the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District shall order said election if a majority of the Prairie View City Council adopts an ordinance requesting a continuation, after notice and public hearing on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at its a meeting on August 14, 2021, the Prairie View City Council, after notice thereof as required by law, held a public hearing on the questions of whether to continue the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District, at which hearing all persons were given the opportunity to present evidence on the matter; and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing, the Prairie View City Council desires that the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District and its one-fourth cent (.002500) sales tax be continued for an additional five (5) years, and that the Board of Directors of the District order a referendum election to be held on November 2, 2021, on continuation of same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Prairie View City Council requests the Board of Directors of the Prairie View Crime Control and Prevention District to order a referendum election to be held on November 2, 2021, on the continuation of the district and its one-fourth cent sales (.002500) tax for five (5) years, at which election the qualified voters residing in the District shall have the opportunity to vote for or against the following proposition;

“Whether the PRAIRIE VIEW Crime Control and Prevention District should be continued for five (5) years and the Crime Control and Prevention District sales tax of one-fourth cent (.002500) should be continued for five (5) years.”

Section 2. The election shall be conducted according to the Texas Election Code and the Texas Constitution. Election Day voting will be conducted on November 2, 2021, from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. The polling place for Election Day shall be located at:

Section 3. The City Secretary, along with any additional designees, shall serve as the early voting clerk. Early voting begins Monday, October 18, 2021, and ends on Friday, October 29, 2021. Extended voting hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. will be on October 25, 2021 and October 26, 2021. Application for ballots by mail shall be submitted to the City Secretary, P.O. Box 817, Prairie View, Texas, 77446. The main Early Voting location shall be located at:

Section 4. That Notice of the elections ordered herein, be given in the manner prescribed by Texas Election Code Ann., Title 1, Chapter 4, Sections 4.003, 4.004, 4.007 and 4.008, and a record of notice of the election be retained as provided in Texas Election Code Section 4.005.


Section 5. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 6. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, as amended.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
