

## **CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW**

The City of Prairie View, Texas, is seeking a progressive and innovative Police Chief to provide management and leadership to its police department.

The department currently consists of five sworn officers, and reserve officers. We operate a 24 hour patrol service for our 5,670 population. Prairie View A&M University is within our city but has its own Police Department. Prairie View is one of several smaller cities in Waller County just 30 miles from the Houston Metropolitan area on Highway 290. The Chief in addition to providing management and leadership is expected to be a "working" Chief, providing assistance to the patrol and investigative function when needed.

The successful candidate will have five years of experience as a Chief of Police or the second in command of a small or mid-size agency. He/She will demonstrate high integrity and have at least 15 years of experience in law enforcement and at least five years as a supervisor. A TCLEOSE Advanced Certificate is required but a Master Certificate is preferred. Associate or Bachelor's degree is a plus, as is investigative experience, an instructor's certificate, and any advanced law enforcement management classes. Salary Commission with experience and qualifications. Benefits include a vehicle or vehicle allowance, medical shared plans and retirement plan.
