In an effort to minimize the threat of the Coronavirus outbreak in The City of Prairie View, the City is taking the following proactive measures for **general public at City Hall**.

1. Until further notice, access City Hall for pertinent business only.
2. If possible, when handling your business with City Hall, utilize alternate methods of communication, *(telephone, email, etc.)*
3. When visiting City Hall, please use the sanitizing stations in designated areas of the building.
4. Avoid touching door handles, and door knobs as much as is possible.
5. All meetings, gatherings, and after-hours entry in City Hall have been suspended throughout the end of March 2020; or until further notice.
6. If you are ill, or have traveled overseas, please avoid City Hall, and utilize alternate methods of communication.

These measures are to mitigate the risk of contamination and further spreading of this virus, which is unknown and more serious than SARS and Ebola.
